Name

1. This Regulation shall be referred to as the Smoke Free Environment Policy.

Source

2. This Regulation is made pursuant to rule 32 of the Constitution of Table Tennis South Australia Incorporated (TTSA).

Policy Statement

3. TTSA is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment at all sporting and social events that we hold or endorse. In general, our policy is that:
 - no smoking shall occur at or near sporting events involving children and young people under the age of 18. This policy shall apply to coaches, players, trainers, officials and volunteers;
 - social events shall be smoke-free, with smoking permitted at designated outdoor smoking areas; and
 - coaches, officials, trainers, volunteers and players will refrain from smoking while they are involved in an official capacity in our sport, both on and off the field.
4. Smoking is prohibited in all stadiums, halls and other venues used by affiliated Clubs and Associations and TTSA including:
 - playing areas;
 - all office space;
 - tournament control areas;
 - conference, meeting and training rooms;
 - toilets and change rooms;
 - storerooms, photocopy areas, computer rooms;
 - reception and public waiting areas;
 - areas of high foot traffic in and around stadium entrances;
 - all areas designated as non-smoking areas by legislation or regulation for safety reasons.
5. Cigarette products will not be sold within stadiums, halls etc. used by affiliated Clubs and Associations and TTSA.
6. No Smoking signage will be on display in venues used by TTSA for competitions and tournaments, and signage will be made available to affiliated Clubs and Associations for display in prominent positions in venues used by those affiliates.

7. Appropriate signage will be displayed in entranceways to advise of this Policy, and spectators and other visitors to table tennis venues will be courteously asked to observe the smoking prohibition. Any member or visitor who refuses to comply with this Policy will be courteously asked to leave the premises.

Non-Compliance

8. In adopting this Policy Table Tennis SA emphasizes that it is implemented in the interest of the health of all members, and does not seek to discriminate personally against members or any other group who are smokers.
9. Non-compliance with this policy will result in (specific action) being taken by the TTSA Board of Management.
10. Anyone wishing to discuss any aspect of this Policy is invited to contact a member of the TTSA Board of Management.

Policy Review

11. The Non-Smoking Policy will be reviewed on every 2 years with any changes to be provided to all affiliates.
