CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Tournament will be held under the ITTF Rules and Regulations unless otherwise varied by supplementary Rules & Regulations implemented by TTA and / or TTSA.
2. All events will be the best of five (5) games to 11 points unless otherwise stipulated.
3. All singles events will commence with a round robin (groups of 3) as a lead in to the main draw. All other events will be conducted on a 'knock-out' basis (unless less than 4 entries in the event).
4. The D40+ DHS 3-Star Plastic White Ball will be used for all events.
5. All Players are required to assist with umpiring.
6. All competitors must be registered members of a Club or Association affiliated with a State Association affiliated with TTA.
7. Dress regulations of the ITTF will be enforced. No clothing of predominantly the same colour as the nominated ball may be worn. Any question of legality or acceptability of dress shall be decided by the Referee. No tracksuits or part thereof may be worn while playing except with the permission of the referee.
8. Each match shall be controlled by an Umpire, whose decision shall be final in point of fact. The Referee's decision shall be final on any interpretation of the Rules.
9. Any player not ready to play when called may be disqualified.
10. Completed score cards must be initialled and returned promptly by the winning player after each match.
11. A 2 minute warm-up period will be allowed and play must commence promptly after this time.
12. No gluing of rackets is permitted in the playing area. Only approved glue or glue sheets may be used.
13. This tournament is conducted pursuant to TTSA Policies and Regulations. It is a condition of entry that all players agree to abide by these policies and regulations and are liable for any breaches.

The Tournament Committee / Director shall have the sole management of the tournament and its decision will be final, including the right to:

- 1) Cancel any event due to insufficient entries
 - 2) Refuse an entry
 - 3) Alter times of play if necessary
 - 4) Add late entries where players have withdrawn due to illness or injury in accordance with I.T.T.F regulations
14. **ELIGIBILITY.** Age as at 31st December 2018.
 15. Singles and Men's Doubles - Players may only play in 2 adjoining age groups (30/40, 40/50, 50/60, 60/65, 65/70, 70/75).
 - 15a. Women's and Mixed Doubles – Maintain touching age group concept while aligning with 'player information' relating to women's and mixed doubles information overleaf (next page).
 16. Where no substantiated justification exists, players who fail to pay their entry fees will be subject to restriction from entering future SA tournaments.

PLAYER INFORMATION:

A TTSA Tournament Review Committee met following the 2017 sanctioned tournament season to review event patronage and the general running of tournaments. This has led to a few changes in 2018 which are being trialled. These being...

- Mixed doubles events were not being well patronized. Thus, there are now only 3 mixed doubles events, O30 (for O30 & O40 players), O50 (for O50 & O60 players) and O65 (for O65, O70 & O75 players), and
- Due to the lack of females playing veteran table tennis in some age groups, the number of Women's Doubles has been reduced to 2 women's doubles events, namely O30 (for O30, O40 & O50 players) and O60 (for O60, O65, O70 & O75 players).

Additionally, Southern will make the first round of singles events as round robins (groups of 3). This will provide competitors with more matches for their money. However, to avoid unnecessary long tournament days, a player can only go in a maximum of 5 events.

ABOUT THIS ENTRY FORM:

This is an online smart 'PFD' entry form. In addition to the smarts when completing the form (eg DOB and 'member of' fields), provision exists to press a button to automatically launch your email system, already addressed with your entry form appended. This can be done from a computer / laptop / tablet or smart phone. To access all the features, open this smart pdf in its native application, that being Adobe / Acrobat Reader. Note – Adobe is an 'app' which can be downloaded on tablets and smart phones. Otherwise, the pdf entry form can be completed in any web browser.
